The title was an anagram of TALCUM POWER, the English name of an Italian film released in 1982. (A year Italy won the World Cup.) The title that the players may use is its Italian name BOROTALCO, which could be found in the correct letters of misprints. Two entries MAORI and BARGE had to be modified before entry to form MARIO BREGA one of the actors (or players). Extra letters from 15 across clues gave CHRISTIAN DE SICA and from down clues ROBERTA MANFREDI, two more of the cast. Another four had to be highlighted in the grid. ANGELO INFANTI, CARLO VERDONE, ELEONORA GIORGI, and ENRICO PAPA.

Setter's note. I appreciate that the film may not be familiar to solvers so tried to ensure that someone who wasn't aware of it had sufficient information from extra letters and misprints to find it and solve the puzzle.
